

WESTON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE UPDATE
JULY 26, 2018

Weston County Road & Bridge currently has eight full-time Road & Bridge employees, including one mechanic and Superintendent Rick Williams. Two part-time, summer employees are hauling gravel and mowing.

The following projects are currently underway and scheduled for summer/fall 2018:

Weston County Road & Bridge is spotting gravel on County Roads. Last week alone, the County spent over \$100,000.00 on J-base gravel to be applied to the roads. On average, Road & Bridge employees are hauling about five loads of gravel a day.

CMAQ bids for Morrissey Road and Grieves Road will be opened on July 30th. These projects will include new gravel in spots of the road, and magnesium chloride application for dust control. Morrissey Road is approved for \$100,000.000 in grant funds and \$25,000.00 of County Funds; Grieves is approved for \$190,000.00 of grant funds and \$47,500.00 from County Funds.

Two bridge-to-culvert projects are scheduled to start this fall: Upton Fairview/Fiddler Creek and Lynch/Little Thunder Crossing. The County's engineer is waiting for WYDOT approval on these projects. Road & Bridge is planning to replace culverts on Materi Road and Howard Road.
