Weston County Currently does not have a designated Emergency Operations Center (EOC). In the event of an emergency, an EOC is where the command center would be located. Homeland Security funds are available to equip a center but not to construct or remodel a building. Currently, the EOC has been operational in the small dispatch center located in a small area of the law enforcement building which houses the sheriff's department and the Newcastle Police department. The basement of the building is currently a parking garage and evidence storage area. This proposal is Phase I of III to upgrade the building. Phase I includes construction of an EOC but also requires that plumbing and electrical requirements be installed for phase II and phase IIII. This preplanning will insure that Phase I construction is not demolished in phase II & III. An architect's estimate for bathrooms, conference room and an increased security evidence storage area is \$300,000.00. This is Phase I of the project. The Commissioners believe this is the most economical place to house an EOC and would allow enough room for several agencies to meet.

#### Dear Grantee:

On August 7, 2008 the State Loan and Investment Board approved a grant from Chapter 26 – Capital Improvement Projects – Countywide Consensus List Awards (Block Allocations) up to \$300,000.00 to assist in funding a Emergency Operations Center Construction Project-Phase 1.

This letter will serve as notice of grant conditions and instructions on how this office will disburse funds for this project.

#### Conditions:

The State Loan and Investment Board agrees to furnish said granted funds only as needed to discharge obligations incurred by the Grantee; and requests for disbursements of said funds shall be supported by adequate proof by the Grantee that such obligations have been incurred for the purpose for which the grant was made, and are then due and owing.

The Grantee agrees that the granted funds are to be spent only for the following described purpose or project, and for no other project or purpose: Emergency Operations Center Construction Project-Phase 1.

Disbursement requests submitted will be paid by percentage only, and not paid in full. The percentage of payment is based on the amount approved by the State Loan and Investment Board as a percentage of the total eligible project cost given in the application. The State Loan and Investment Board's disbursement percentage for this project is 100%.

If the State Loan and Investment Board provide additional funding for this project, the office will recalculate the disbursement percentage and the office will make disbursements based upon that percentage. The office will allow additional payments to bring the State Loan and Investment Board's disbursement percentage to the current percentage approved by the Board.

If any of the granted funds are not utilized for the above-described project or purpose, the Grantee shall repay such funds immediately to the State Loan and Investment Board. The Grantee further agrees to provide the State Loan and Investment Board upon request, a full and

complete accounting as to the use and distribution of the granted funds; said accounting to be done in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and shall be provided the State Loan and Investment Board within a reasonable time upon request. The Grantee further understands and agrees that the State Loan and Investment Board may perform an audit or examination of the books and records of the grant at any time and without notice, and that said Board or its designee may at any time without notice perform on-site visits and inspections of the project being funded.

#### Proposed Project Timeline:

Today, I discussed this project with my consulting engineer team, and based on that discussion, we have created an approximate schedule for developing and completing this project.

Presently, we are working on the redesign of the entire lower level, in order to fit all the requested components into the project. Because renovation of the entire space is included now, and the nature of the design now includes public assembly spaces that were not part of the original design, the plumbing, mechanical, and electrical designs must all be nearly completely redesigned.

Based on those obligations, there will be additional design fees required, and higher plan review fees than originally anticipated. The original and amended construction cost estimates for remodeling the space were in the range of \$800,000 to \$950,000, plus the design costs. Due to the requested design revisions, more of the original project funding will we used for the increased fee

In response to your request, I propose the following <u>estimated</u> schedule, based on approved design solutions:

Design programming and code review is in progress.



Subject: Weston Co Law Enforcement Center Renovation

I am writing to express concern that funds allocated for the renovation of the Weston County Law Enforcement Center (LEC) might be at risk. As initially allocated the funds were dedicated to a renovation that would create a County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and additional officer training space. The County has never had an EOC. Creating one in the basement of the LEC would be an important step in improving community preparedness and interoperable communications in the County; both State priorities from the Wyoming Office of Homeland Security (WOHS).

As the renovation plans were nearing completion the County was faced with a new problem: increased State emphasis on Court Security. An inspection by the Wyoming Court Security Commission (WCSC) indicated severe security problems with the Circuit Court in Newcastle. The Sheriff wisely decided to solve that problem by including a courtroom in the LEC renovation in place of the originally planned officer space. This solution fixed two major problems with one pot of money, but additional time was required to revise the blueprints. Unfortunately that additional time has run up against a monetary deadline.

Everything takes longer in a rural community and this project is a perfect example. We have no local architects so all coordination and communication must be done in a long distance manner. We have taken longer to get this project off the ground, but I firmly believe that the results will be much better because of that.

I request that additional time be granted to Weston County to complete the proposed renovation properly. We should spend money wisely and prudently, not fast and without thought.

#### PROJECT MEMORANDUM:

#### Project review:

In January, 2011, I had several communications with Sheriff Colvard, Doug Jorrey, and Ray Pacheco, regarding the options available for proceeding with this project. At the time the design was established, and we had proceeded with the construction documents. There was an on-going discussion about how to phase the construction work on the project, because there were insufficient funds for the total project.

Initial construction estimates from 2005 to 2009 had established the project costs for design and construction of the complete project as nearly \$950,000. Because the funding at the time was basically a \$300,000 grant, it was apparent that the project would have to be completed in phases. The project design had elements essential to both law enforcement and homeland security, plus there was an immediate need to replace the inoperative emergency generator.

The generator was secured through other funding, but the connections and other remodel work necessary, plus initial fuel, were taken from this project's funds. Also, all design and review fees were required to be taken from this fund. I provided a project summary in February, 2011, which outlined the breakdown of the funds spent and the estimated costs to continue. A search for additional funding was continuing.

We discussed several methods to separate the project into an initial Phase One, which would get the project underway, but we did not reach a conclusion of what elements would fit into Phase One. After discussions with local contractors about costs, it was estimated that the initial funding would be depleted in just the initial demolition and underground utility work and very little reconstruction work. Design work was continued while a search for additional funds was underway.

This week, I was informed that there has been additional funds added to this project. Apparently, the funds are near \$500,000, with additional money to come.

In late 2012, we met to consider major revisions to the project. These revisions primarily included adding circuit court and clerk of court spaces to the project design, and complete redesign of the spaces already in the project. Because of the nature of the court space, this turns the building into a different building code classification, and the new 2012 Building Code was enacted. The new code requirements change the project in several ways, including addition costs. The building's configuration built into the hillside makes it difficult to find ways to install proper additional exits required for the new design. We are working on this design.

My consultant engineers for plumbing, mechanical, and electrical will be required to almost fully redesign those systems from the design previously completed. This firm was not available for design work for the first portion of 2013. We are working on this revised design now.

Because of the new design elements, there will be additional costs for construction, including additional exterior work and fire sprinkler work. In addition, new building code requirements are changing the design requirements for fire ratings, and this will have to be addressed because of the wood construction floor/ceiling above this space. There is very limited means available to address the low headroom circumstances in this space, which requires creative distribution of heating and air conditioning. The mechanical requirements of a courtroom are more complex. To make a court work successfully in a better way than the current circumstances, it is necessary to increase certain elements in the design to keep public spaces accessible and separated from the secure areas, including non-shared restrooms. We are working on this design. When we reach an approved design solution, we will have to produce a new construction cost estimate to accommodate the revised design.

Questions have arisen during the design. Has the county ever conducted investigation analyses of this building to determine if there are potential hazards in the construction, primarily asbestos materials or lead paint. These questions should be addressed prior to any demolition.

Because of the new design work, additional fees will be required for architectural and engineering work. These will be provided to you when they are confirmed with the design team.

We are proceeding with design and code compliance. The construction drawings we had partially completed will need to be redesigned when the new project plan is approved.
