> Hello, Bill. Thanks for speaking with me, today, about the possible
> new solid waste district. As I mentioned, I attached a copy of the
> Chapter 21 Rules and Regulations that you may find helpful. Of
> course, I am available to try and answer questions.
>
> I also attached a copy of the letter that I was going to send to you
> in response to the letter you sent about possibly dissolving Central
> Weston County Solid Waste Disposal (CWCSWD). I figured I may as well
> attach this.
>
> It sounds like the possible options are the following:
>
> * dissolve CWCSWD and create a county-wide solid waste disposal
> district
> * Expand/annex CWCSWD to include the whole county
> * Create a ne solid waste disposal around the current district
> (CWCSWD)
>
> If it is decided to dissolve CWCSWD, it would be best to dissolve
> this
> first and then form the new district. Any of these decisions, if
> approved, are for taxyear 2016. So, there is time--as long as we have
> it before the end of the year. Of course, it is best to have it in
> sooner than later, just in case there are some issues that arise.
>

> Whatever is decided, please send in a petition for formation where we
> can approve the boundary. The DOR will want to make sure it doesn't
> conflict with any other districts. If the decision to dissolve CWCSWD
> is made, the petition for formation will come after the dissolution.
>
> After approving the petition for formation, and a resolution is
> signed
> by county commissioners, please send to the DOR the resolution, map
> and/or legal. We like to have both map and legal just in case there
> is
> a discrepancy.
>
> Please don't hesitate to call, anytime.
>
