A motion was made by Commissioner Rossman, seconded by Commissioner Shepperson, to appoint Alan Parks to an un-expired term, ending July 2017, on the Mondell Field Airport Board. Weston County Mill Levies

Tina Conklin, Weston County Assessor, met with the Commissioners to review the Weston County mill levies for tax year 2014.
