The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss Weston County's Subdivision Rules and Regulations.

Subdivision Rules and Regulations

Joe Sandrini, Planning & Zoning Board, discussed possible amendments to Weston County's Subdivision Rules & Regulations, to include a category for subdivisions containing seventy-five units and over. Mr. Sandrini walked the Commissioners through a draft of the proposed changes. Discussion ensued. Chapter Five, which will define the new category, was discussed in detail. Several changes to proposed verbiage were requested by the Board of Commissioners and Mamie C. Krank, Weston County Clerk. All in attendance agreed that a revised draft of the Subdivision Rules and Regulations will be submitted to the County Clerk by May 23, 2012.
