

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-04
CONCERNING SPECIAL PROSECUTION

WHEREAS the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney has agreed with the Campbell County Attorney's Office and the Crook County Attorney's Office to investigate and otherwise proceed to make, in their sole discretion, a proper disposition of all potential matters in which the Weston County Attorney's Office has declared a conflict of interest; and

WHEREAS the Campbell and Crook County Attorney's Offices will, at their discretion, provide their services free of charge to Weston County in exchange for the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney's Office acting in their county free of charge when conflicts of interest arise in their respective counties, however, the Weston County Attorney's Office shall reimburse them for all travel costs and expenses; and

WHEREAS Wyoming Statute §18-3-302(c) authorizes said action and it benefits Weston County; and

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners in and for Weston County, Wyoming that the Campbell County and Prosecuting Attorney and the Crook County and Prosecuting Attorney and their respective deputies be and the same are hereby authorized to act as special prosecutors in Weston County, Wyoming when appointed by the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney to act as such in any particular case.

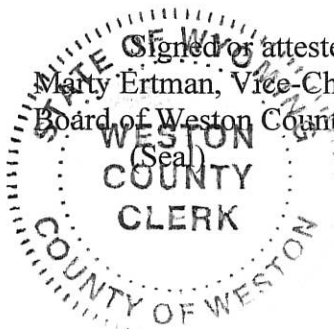
