CHEYENNE, Wyo. – “I respect the difficult work and the hard discussions the Legislature had on the forfeiture issue. I believe improvements can and should be made to civil forfeiture. The Chairman of Judiciary, the Committee and the Legislature as a whole recognized the need for improvement. I commit to work with the Committee and the Legislature on this matter in the interim so we can come back next year with a bill that addresses concerns and leaves law enforcement with the necessary tools to do its work.”
