RESOLUTION #02-2

Resolution to Establish Precinct Boundaries

WHEREAS, the State of Wyoming has been reapportioned into Senatorial and Representative Districts by the 2002 legislature, and

WHEREAS, the reapportionment divided Weston County into two Representative Districts whose dividing line divides the Newcastle Outside election district and precincts; and

WHEREAS, the new representative boundary line is not similar to the current precinct boundaries for 1-1 and 1-2, and

WHEREAS, the Weston County Commissioners advertised three times to hold a hearing to consider changing the precinct boundaries within Weston County, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on April 2, 2002, to consider the proposed changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Weston County Commissioners resolve to divide the Newcastle Outside election district into two precincts using a portion of the boundary line between House District #1 and #2 as a precinct boundary line. The Newcastle Outside precinct which lies wholly north of the boundary line shall be designated as precinct 1-2, and the precinct that lies south of the boundary line shall be designated as precinct 1-1. Weston County will have a total of eight precincts. Precincts 2-1 Osage Area, 3-1 Upton Outside, 4-1 Upton Inside, and 5-1, 5-2, 5-3 Newcastle Inside precincts will continue with the same precinct boundaries as fully described in Commissioners Record Book 8 page 127, allowing for municipal annexations. A map displaying the boundaries is attached as exhibit A and made a part of this resolution by reference.

The Weston County Commissioners further resolve to determine the number of precinct men and women for precincts 1-1 and 1-2 as established by W.S. 22-4-101. Precinct I-1 will have two precinct men and two precinct women for the Republican Party and one precinct man and one precinct woman for the Democratic party. Precinct I-2 will have one precinct man and one precinct women for each party for the 2002 primary election.
