

Resolution

Whereas, for many years the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney and the Crook County and Prosecuting Attorney and their deputies have filled in for each other in their respective counties in cases of conflicts and absences; and

Whereas, the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney and the Crook County and Prosecuting Attorney desire to continue this arrangement for the benefit of their respective counties, and each will handle cases for the other without cost in these situations; and

Whereas, Wyoming Statute 18-3-302 authorizes the board of county commissioners of each county to allow other attorneys to appear and present cases and to assist the county and prosecuting attorney in any action or proceeding;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved By The Board Of County Commissioners of Weston County, Wyoming that the Crook County and Prosecuting Attorney and his deputy or deputies be, and the same are hereby authorized to act as special prosecutors in Weston County, Wyoming, when appointed by the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney to act as such in any particular case.
