## WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING RESOLUTION NO. 06-11

AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF CANYON IMPROVEMENT AND SERVICE DISTRICT, AT A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD FOR THE DISTRICT ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 22, 2006, THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT TO ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN THE MAXIMUM PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$217,000.

WHEREAS, Canyon Improvement and Service District (also known as Canyon Improvement District) (the "District") is a special improvement district duly organized and existing under the provisions of Title 18, Chapter 12, Wyo. Stat. (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board") has determined that the interest of the District and public interest and necessity demand that provision be made for constructing a system for the development, treatment, storage and delivery of potable domestic water to the members of the District and customers thereof (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Board, on April 18, 2006, adopted a resolution (the "Election Resolution") submitting to the qualified electors of the District, at an election to be held on Tuesday, August 22, 2006, the proposition of issuing general obligation bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$217,000, for the purpose of paying part of the cost of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Election Resolution was submitted to the Weston County Clerk on Tuesday, April 25, 2006, the submission of which meets the May 3, 2006, notice requirement of Wyo. Stat. § 22-21-103 and constitutes a request for a bond election to be held on August 22, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Wyo. Stat. § 18-12-122 requires that a bond election of an improvement and service district be called by the board of county commissioners at the request of the district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING:

Section 1. <u>Bond Election</u>. A bond election shall be held for Canyon Improvement and Service District (also known as Canyon Improvement District) on Tuesday, August 22, 2006, pursuant to the procedures and upon the question set forth in the District's Election Resolution.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid and unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.
