**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
OF WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING FOR SPECIAL PROSECUTION**

**Whereas** occasions may arise when the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney's Office has a conflict of interest in investigating and prosecuting a juvenile or criminal matter; and

**Whereas** similar occasions may arise for the Crook County and Prosecuting Attorney's Office; and

**Whereas** these County Attorneys have cooperated with each other in the past in investigation and prosecuting conflict cases for each other, and

**Whereas** the Crook County Attorneys will provide their services free of charge to Weston County in exchange for Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney's offices acting in their county free of charge when conflicts of interest arise to appear and prosecute or defend or assist the county and prosecuting attorney in behalf of the people of the state or Weston County pursuant to Wyoming Statutes 18-3-302(c) and 18-3-520; and

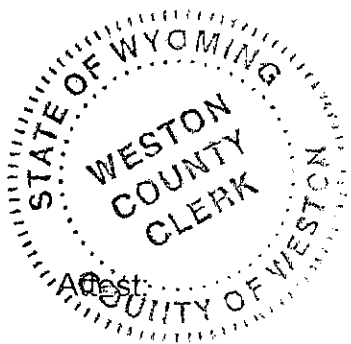
**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved By the Board Of County Commissioners of Weston County, Wyoming:**

1. The Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney may appoint the Crook County and Prosecuting Attorney and any deputy in said office as Special Prosecutors to investigate and prosecute any juvenile or criminal matter in Weston County, Wyoming, in which the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney believes there is or may be a conflict of interest. The Special Prosecutors shall not receive any fee for such service.
