PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE OF COUNTY SALES AND USE  
TAX ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the General Election to be held on the 4th day of November, 1980, there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of Weston County, Wyoming, the following question and proposal:

"Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Weston County, Wyoming, be authorized to continue to impose a county sales and use tax at a rate of one percent (1%) upon retail sales of tangible personal property, admissions and services made within the county pursuant to Section 39-6-412 of Wyoming Statutes 1977, and upon sales and storage, use and consumption of tangible personal property within the county pursuant to Section 39-6-518 of Wyoming Statutes 1977, for the purpose of raising funds for general revenue purposes."
