RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION BY WESTON COUNTY FOR THE 1987 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM AND CERTIFYING THAT ALL PUBLIC REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET.

WHEREAS, the primary goal of the CDGB Program is to make grants to authorized applicants to aid in creating and retaining permanent jobs in the State of Wyoming through the construction, rehabilitation and renovation of specific projects that will benefit low to medium income families.

WHEREAS, the Odd Fellow/Rebekah Retirement Home Association (a non-profit corporation) is proposing to renovate the former Weston County Hospital (a vacant facility) into an 18-unit residential care facility for senior citizens.

WHEREAS, Weston County has held a public hearing on the possible uses of CDGB funds on June 2, 1987 at 2:00 p.m. in the County Commissioner's Chambers in Newcastle, Wyoming, and taken public input.

WHEREAS, Weston County has directed the Association's financial advisor, Kaiser and Company, to assist its staff in preparing a grant application in the amount of \$250,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by Weston County, Wyoming, that it is hereby authorized to execute and file an application for a grant to provide necessary construction, renovation and rehabilitation funds to renovate the former Weston County Memorial Hospital into an 18-unit residential care facility for the elderly and it is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information to the State of Wyoming or any other agency may reasonably request in connection with such application and to sign all necessary documents and receive payment.
