WHEREAS: Weston County is a socially and economically impacted county of substantial increase in population attributable to mineral and mineral related development.

WHEREAS: the State of Wyoming Farm Loan Board Administers Government Coal Excise Account Grants and gives priority to projects in communities which are experiencing social and economic impact.

THEREFORE: be it resolved that Weston County file an application to the State of Wyoming Farm Loan Board requesting a Government Coal Excise Account Grant to assist in the financing of gravel for Weston County Oil City, Lynch and Christensen Roads.. Also that by this resolution the Weston County Commissioners consider the need for these roads highly significant owing to the facts:

- (1) These roads are used by Oil Field Personnel.
- (2) They are school bus and mail routes.
- (3) These roads are also farm to market roads for local ranchers.

Further, that this resolution authorizes that the application be signed by the Weston County Commissioners.




RESOLUTION

- (1) Old U.S. Highway 85 is used for an access road by Burlington Northern Railroad for maintenance on their track to Powder River Basin.
 - (2) Old U.S. Highway 85 is a mail route.
 - (3) Old U.S. Highway 85 is used by fisherman to M. W. Lake.
 - (4) Old U.S. Highway 85 is ranch to market road for local residents.
- Further, that this resolution authorizes that the application be signed by the Weston County Commissioners.


