## R E S O L U T I O N

- 87-6

WHEREAS: Weston County is a socially and economically impacted county of substantial increase in population attributable to mineral and mineral related development.

WHEREAS: the State of Wyoming Farm Loan Board Administers Government Mineral Royalty Excise Account Grants and gives priority to projects in communities which are experiencing social and economic impact.

THEREFORE: be it resolved that Weston County file an application to the State of Wyoming Farm Loan Board requesting a Government Mineral Royalty Excise Account Grant to assist in the financing of reconstruction of the Weston County Old U.S. Highway 85 road. Also that by this resolution the Weston County Commissioners consider the need of this road highly significant owing to the facts:

- (1) Old U.S. Highway 85 is used for an access road by Burlington Northern Railroad for maintenance on their track to Powder River Basin.
- (2) Old U.S. Highway 85 is a mail route.
- (3) Old U.S. Highway 85 is used by fishermen to M W Lake.
- (4) Old U.S. Highway 85 is a ranch to market road for local residents.

Further, that this resolution authorizes that the application be signed by the Weston County Commissioners.
