WHEREAS, a proposition for a one percent (1%) county sales and use tax was approved at the last general election, and

WHEREAS, there is an upcoming general election, and

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statute Section 39-6-412(e) requires that the same proposition be submitted at each subsequent general election, and

WHEREAS, recent economic conditions existing in the State of Wyoming have caused a decrease in the county's revenues, and

WHEREAS, the revenue derived from the one percent (1%) county sales and use tax is necessary to fund certain programs and projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposition to continue a one percent (1%) county sales and use tax shall be submitted to the vote of the qualified electors of Weston County, Wyoming, at the general election on November 8, 1988.
