RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT

WHEREAS, Weston County is subject to the provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act; and

WHEREAS, the Weston County Board of County Commissioners passed and adopted a resolution on December 17, 1985 regarding the Fair Labor Standards Act; and

WHEREAS, the Weston County Board of County Commissioners desires to fully comply with all of the provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING, THAT:

1. All elected officials and/or supervisors shall be responsible for keeping accurate time records for each and every employee within their control.
2. All compensatory time worked by any employee shall be approved by the employee's immediate supervisor in advance and the employee's supervisor shall keep records of all work and tasks performed on compensatory time and the reasons necessitating compensatory time.
3. All compensatory time accumulated by any employee shall be taken and used by the employee within the next pay period.
