RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Highway 85 is a commercial trade and tourism route and has the opportunity to become the first north/south international highway in the western United States and Canada; and

WHEREAS, Highway 85 originates in Regina, Saskatchewan, Canada and bisects the western third of the United States, passing through North Dakota, South Dakota, Wyoming, Colorado, New Mexico, and Texas; and

WHEREAS, The CanAm International Highway Association was formed in Regina, Saskatchewan, Canada, for the purpose of promoting the CanAm Highway and to support and encourage all plans for improvement, maintenance, and beautification of the route; and

WHEREAS, The advertisement and promotion of the CanAm International Highway Route would aid communities in efforts toward business retention and expansion through attraction of commercial travelers and tourists into the region, especially in light of recent legislation in favor of Canadian/American Free Trade; and

WHEREAS, The Wyoming State Highway Commission's official policy for designation of State Highways requires approval of the board of county commissioners through which proposed designated highways pass, prior to granting such approval and subsequent placement of trailblazer markers.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:


