RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO ORGANIZATION OF THE SIX-COUNTY
CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT AREA IN NORTHEASTERN WYOMING

WHEREAS the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture is charged with the responsibility for the Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) program under Public Law 97-98, 16 U.S.C. 3451-3461.

WHEREAS the purpose of the RC&D program is to accelerate the conservation, development, and utilization of natural resources to improve the general level of economic activity and to enhance the environment and standard of living in authorized RC&D areas.

WHEREAS authorized areas are a locally sponsored area designated by the Secretary of Agriculture for RC&D technical and financial assistance program funds.

WHEREAS the Secretary of Agriculture, through authorities delegated to the Soil Conservation Service and other USDA agencies, makes available to states, local units of government, and local nonprofit organizations technical and financial assistance necessary to operate and maintain an RC&D area.

WHEREAS the RC&D program was created on the assumption that local citizens, primarily in rural areas, with coordinated assistance provided through the USDA, could develop and carry out an action-oriented plan for the social, economic, and environmental betterment of their communities.

WHEREAS the coordinator will be provided to assist the council (sponsor representatives) in carrying out the objectives and goals they themselves established.

WHEREAS the counties proposed for these RC&D areas in northeastern Wyoming are Sheridan, Johnson, Campbell, Niobrara, Weston, and Crook.

WHEREAS the proposed sponsors of the RC&D area are the county commissioners, cities and towns, and conservation districts of each county within the proposed RC&D area.

WHEREAS the specific proposed sponsors listed with signature of official become a sponsor of the RC&D area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the local entity signing this resolution is expressing their interest and support and will be a sponsor of the proposed RC&D area in Wyoming. This program is administered by the State Conservationist of the Soil Conservation Service in Casper, Wyoming.
