

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CONSTRUCTION
OF BEAVER CREEK RESERVOIR

WHEREAS, Beaver Creek, a creek running through Weston County, floods at regular intervals; and

WHEREAS, the floodwaters are a valuable natural resource which currently escape utilization; and

WHEREAS, studies have been conducted which indicate the floodwaters are of sufficient quantity and quality to be impounded in a reservoir, thereby allowing them to be put to a beneficial use; and

WHEREAS, the reservoir would provide a much needed and sadly lacking recreational facility for Northeast Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, we the Weston County Commissioners are willing to commit financial support for one-fourth (1/4) of the estimated 2.4 million dollar cost of the project,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that we, the Weston County Board of County Commissioners, are in support of the construction of a dam on Beaver Creek in Weston County in order to create Beaver Creek Reservoir for the purposes set forth herein, and further

BE IT RESOLVED that Weston County will fund one fourth (1/4) of the project's estimated 2.4 million dollar cost
