R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS: Weston County is socially and economically depressed due to the decline in mineral and mineral related development.

WHEREAS: the State of Wyoming Farm Loan Board Admin-
ists Government Mineral Royalty Excise
Account Grants and gives priority to projects
in communities which are experiencing social
and economic depression.

THEREFORE: be it resolved that Weston County file an
application to the State of Wyoming Farm Loan
Board requesting a Government Mineral Royalty
Excise Account Grant to assist in the
financing of reconstruction of the Weston
County Upton-Fairview Road. Also, that by
this resolution the Weston County Commis-
sioners consider the need of this road highly
significant owing to the facts:

- (1) Upton-Fairview Road is used by oil field
personnel to get to their leases, wells
and to move their products.
- (2) Upton-Fairview Road is a school bus
route.
- (3) Upton-Fairview Road is a ranch to market
road.

Further, that this resolution authorizes that the appli-
cation be signed by the Weston County Commissioners.
