R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS: Weston County is socially and economically depressed due to the decline in mineral and mineral related development.

WHEREAS: the State of Wyoming Farm Loan Board Administers Government Mineral Royalty Excise Account Grants and gives priority to projects in communities which are experiencing social and economic depression.

THEREFORE: be it resolved that Weston County file an application to the State of Wyoming Farm Loan Board requesting a Government Mineral Royalty Excise Account Grant to assist in the financing of County Wide Bridge Replacement in Weston County. Also, that by this resolution the Weston County Commissioners consider the need of this road highly significant owing to the facts:

- (1) Bridges have been declared unsafe as they are single lane bridges.
- (2) The bridges are misaligned and unsafe for legal load weights.
- (3) Many of the bridges are fifty (50) years old or older.

Further, that this resolution authorizes that the application be signed by the Weston County Commissioners.
