Resolution to Change Precinct Boundaries

- WHEREAS, the State of Wyoming has been reapportioned into Senatorial and Representative Districts by the 1992 Legislature, and
- WHEREAS, the reapportionment divided Weston County into two Representative Districts whose dividing line is not similar to the current precinct boundaries, and
- WHEREAS, the Weston County Commissioners advertised to hold a hearing to consider changing the precinct boundaries within Weston County, and
- WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on May 5th, 1992, to consider changing the precinct boundaries.
- NOW, THEREFORE, the Weston County Commissioners resolve to establish a new precinct entitled 1-2, and to designate all eight of the precinct boundaries as indicated on the following map, retaining the boundaries of the Newcastle precincts to coincide with the city wards.

The Weston County Commissioners further resolve to determine the number of precinct men and women for precinct 1-2 as established by W.S. 22-4-101. Precinct 1-2 will have one precinct man and one precinct woman for each party for the 1992 election.
