

RESOLUTION
CLOSING WESTON COUNTY TO USE LIKELY TO CAUSE
FIRE AND PROHIBITION ON OPEN FLAME



WHEREAS, favorable weather conditions in previous years have resulted in unusually high levels of fine, flashy fuels and these fuels are now drying;

WHEREAS, Mike Dollison, Acting Weston County Fire Warden, has deemed the fire danger in the entire area of Weston County to be extreme and has made certain recommendations to the Weston County Board of County Commissioners regarding prohibition on open flames;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to W. S. § 35-9-301 et seq. effective immediately, the Weston County Board of County Commissioners hereby close to the public the entire unincorporated areas of Weston County to any form of use likely to cause fire and specifically the Board hereby imposes a prohibition on any type of open fire. Said closure and prohibition shall remain in effect until lifted by similar decree.

IN WITNESSS HEREOF, and on behalf of the Weston County Board of County Commissioners the foregoing Resolution is passed and enacted this 6th day of July, 1994.
