WHEREAS, revenues for Weston County's general fund which provide for fire protection are steadily declining, and


WHEREAS, citizens of Weston County and the Weston County firefighters have requested the Weston County Commissioners to place a fire district formation question on the November 8, 1994, election ballot.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Weston County Commissioners request the Weston County Clerk to place the following ballot proposition on the general election ballot for the November 8, 1994, election:

"SHALL THERE BE ESTABLISHED A FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TO PROVIDE PROTECTION FROM FIRE TO ALL PERSONS AND PROPERTY WITHIN THE PROPOSED DISTRICT BOUNDARIES WHICH SHALL BE DESCRIBED AS ALL UNINCORPORATED AREAS WITHIN WESTON COUNTY AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED THREE (3) MILLS ON EACH DOLLAR OF ASSESSED VALUATION OF PROPERTY WITHIN THE PROPOSED DISTRICT?"


