Whereas the Crook County and Prosecuting Attorney will provide services free of charge to Weston County in exchange for the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney's office acting in Crook County free of charge when conflicts of interest arise, and

Whereas Wyoming Statutes 18-3-302 and 18-3-520 authorize said action and it benefits Weston County,

Now Therefore, be it resolved that the Crook County and Prosecuting Attorney and Deputy be authorized to act as special prosecutor when appointed by the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney to act as a special prosecutor in any particular case.
