RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING

Whereas the 53rd Legislature of the State of Wyoming amended certain laws governing the hours of sale of alcoholic and malt beverages: and

Whereas the Board of County Commissioners of Weston County, Wyoming, as local licensing authority, was given authority to regulate the hours of sale.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved By the Board of County Commissioners of Weston County, Wyoming, That:

- Pursuant to the authority granted to Weston County, Wyoming, and as local licensing authority pursuant to Section 12-5-101(a) W.S., 1977. as amended effective July 1, 1996, all licensees holding a license issued by Weston County, Wyoming, may open the dispensing room at 6:00 a.m. and shall close the dispensing room and cease the sale of both alcoholic and malt beverages promptly at the hour of 2:00 a.m. the following day. These hours shall apply every day of the week, including Sunday.
 - 2. This Resolution shall take effect July 1, 1996.
