## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the danger from forest and range fires on State and Private land in Weston County have reached an extreme point; and,

WHEREAS, the extremely wet year and good growing conditions have lead to the growth of above normal amounts of fine flashy fuels and these fuels are now drying; and,

WHEREAS, closure may be invoked in accordance with Section WS 35-9-303 and WS 35-9-301, and the recommendation of the County Fire Warden;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Ted M. Elliott, Chairman of Weston County Commissioners, do hereby declare a state of extreme fire danger to exist; and therefore, on <u>August 6</u>, 1996 order partial closure over all the lands described as follows until the fire danger is reduced:
