The first grade from Upton also visited the library and received their books as well as bookmarks, pencils and other goodies. The library hosted a book signing for Nicholas Trandahl, for his latest book called "Pulling Words".

Brenda presented the foundation report. They have given the library money for a copier and books. They will sell peaches again in August, as well as hold a raffle for Broncos tickets to help replace funds.

Old business was the internet usage policy which had been revised and approved on the first reading. Kim moved to approve it, seconded by Becky.

New business was a brief discussion on the FY2018 budget. Brenda will ask the commissioners for an increase in the administration budget line relating to part-time employees. Board vacancies were discussed. Jamie and Pat have served their term. There is a volunteer for the summer reading program who is 12 years old. A discussion was held on age.
