The reading of the minutes and the treasurer's report were postponed until the next meeting. Cathy reported a discrepancy in her figures and the bookkeepers, so she was still working on the report.

Brenda presented the director's report. The library is once again hosting the VITA (VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE) program. She attended the Every Library Institute online webinar in early February as well as the meeting with Dave Lerner from Wyoming Network that discussed upgrades for the website. Plans for the summer reading program are underway with the theme of A Universe of Stories. The children's librarian continues to read to four different groups. The daily attendance at the library for the month was 2135.
