

Weston County Library Board Minutes for February 21, 2018

Paul Patterson called the meeting to order at 11:40. Attending were: Cathy Dunford, Kim Conzelman, Brenda Mahoney-Ayres, Paul Patterson and Becky Todd. Following a moment of silence, and consideration of the agenda, Becky read the minutes from the last meeting. Kim moved to approve the minutes, seconded by Cathy and the motion carried.

Cathy presented the treasurer's report. To date, 52.82% of the funds have been spent, which is right on track. Becky moved, seconded by Kim to accept the report.

Brenda reported that the program "Understanding Islam from the Outside" continues to be well attended with two weeks remaining. The Internal Revenue Service's Volunteer Income Tax Preparation has begun and will continue until April 16th. Work has begun on the summer reading program and Brenda will attend the state legislative reception.

Sherri, who wasn't able to attend due to the meeting date change, sent a report for the Upton Branch Library. She has continued to read to several groups, met with the Lego group and is also beginning work for the summer reading program. March 9th will be the open house for the celebration of 50 years in Upton.
