OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Corona Virus (Covid-19) Update
 - a. Received the fourteenth continuation from the State on 10/14/2020.
 - b. Weston County has 60 active cases, total 148 as of 10-28-2020. May 29th first case recorded, August 21st Weston County recorded 8 cases, August 28th recorded 12 cases, September 4th recoded 14 cases, September 18th recorded 17 cases, September 27th recorded 27 cases. October 2nd recorded 30 cases, October 9th recorded 35 cases, October 16th recorded 55 cases, and October 23rd recorded 91 cases. We can see an increase in cases week after week. We need to urge people to take precautions, use mask, wash hands and stay six feet apart. We need to try to help open the manner. They are isolated in their rooms. The community needs to be at 10% or under to help open and be 14 days COVID free in the facility. Received a new shipment of PPE and going through this fast.
 - c. November 4th the National Guard will be done with their assignment. Wyoming will look to hire contact tracing company to take over as everyone is overwhelmed. Wyoming is in the top five worst case with North Dakota and South Dakota being near the top.
