- 1. Corona Virus (Covid-19) Update
 - a. Received the Eighteenth Continuation from the State on 12/7/2020.
 - b. New Mask Mandate starting 12/9/2020.
 - i. Variance has been applied for to the state.
 - c. Weston County has 354 active cases, 0 lab confirmed cases in the past 24 hours, 27 active lab confirmed cases, 74 probable cases. 399 total cases recovered, 327 lab confirmed cases and 72 probable cases recovered. 2 COVID-19 related deaths as of 12/10/2020.
 - i. 436 active cases as of 12/16/2020.
 - ii. Discussion from interest from citizens presented to the county commissioners to remove Mike Jording as the County Health Officer. If Jording was removed this would revert back to the State Health Officers. Discussions where the orders were issued from the state health officer not the county health officer.
 - iii. Hometown is conducting testing along with the hospital. Public health is cautious with the numbers as our case numbers did take a rise. Lab reports seems to be delayed from what is being reported. A lot of this is from more people being tested and labs being overwhelmed. There is a huge delay if people go to South Dakota to get tested and not concerned about people that reside in another state and only focused on in state numbers.
 - d. Vaccine Update Pfizer is the only approved at this time, the ultra-cold -90°. Madorna is looking at being accepted by the FDA this coming weekend. Weston County has allocations of the Pfizer vaccine but has not shipped yet. Once the Madorna has been accepted we are expected to get this vaccine instead. People are hesitant about getting the vaccine at this time.


