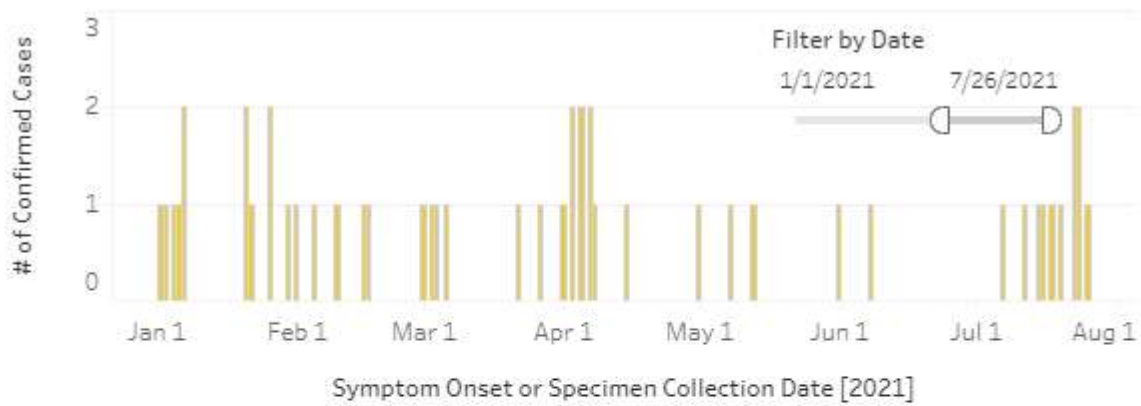

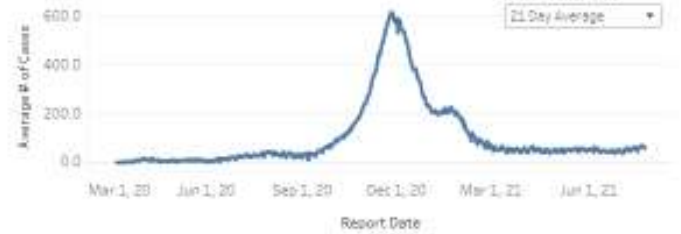

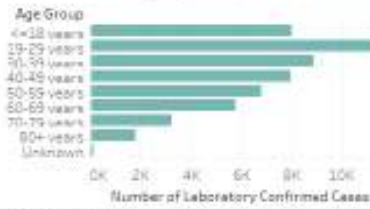
## Lab Confirmed Cases by Symptom Onset or Specimen Collection Date



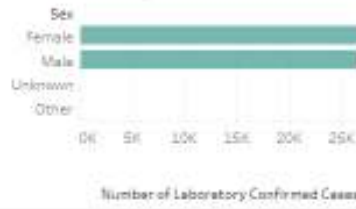
## Average Number of Lab Confirmed Cases by Date of Report
