OLD BUSINESS:

1. Corona Virus (Covid-19) Update
 - a. Discuss cases. Delta Variance was at 0 for Weston County. (Weston County) (as of 8.23.2021). Campbell County hit hard on a waiting list for transfers. Newcastle Ambulance is working to get staffing
 - Total Laboratory Confirmed cases: 615 up from 560 at last report
 - Total New cases Since Last Update: 12 up from 5 at last report
 - Total Laboratory Confirmed Active Cases: 33 up from 8 at last report
 - Total Laboratory Confirmed Cases Recovered: 576 up from 546 at last report
 - Total Laboratory Confirmed Cases in the past 14 days: 41 up from 10 at last report
 - Total Probable Cases: 128
 - Total Probable Cases Recovered: 128 up from 115 at last report

The cad has been the main focus and not the radios. The city will move forward to replace the radio systems as this has been the main problem in dispatch.

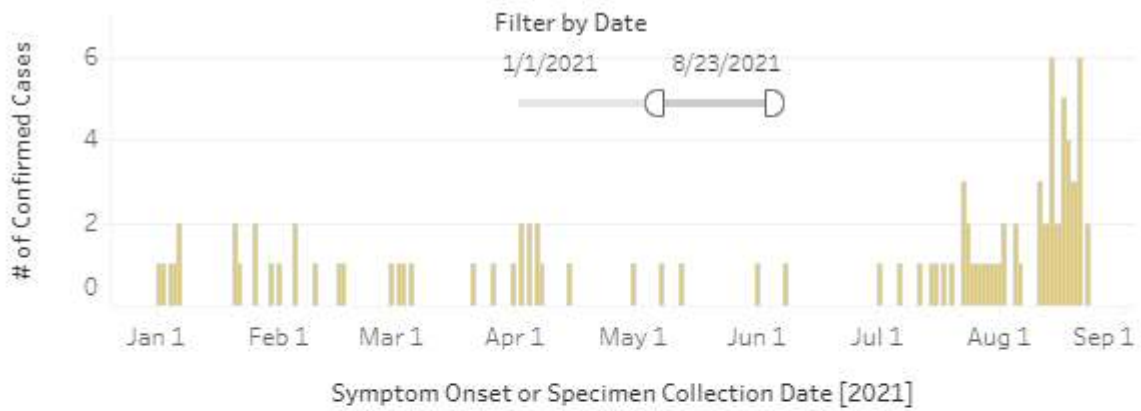
1. LTZ (Landing Zone) Training with Life Flight is scheduled for September 2, 2021, at 1800 at the Firehall.

Lab Confirmed Cases by Symptom Onset or Specimen Collection Date



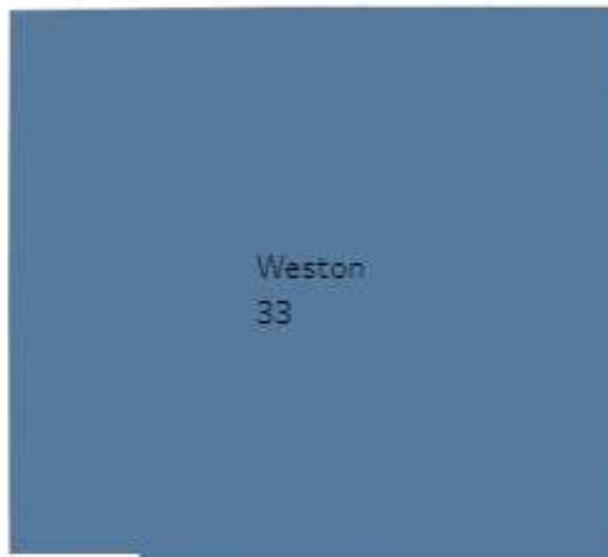
Average Number of Lab Confirmed Cases by Date of Report

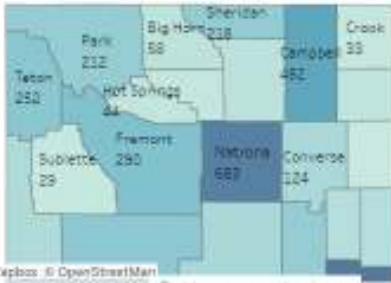

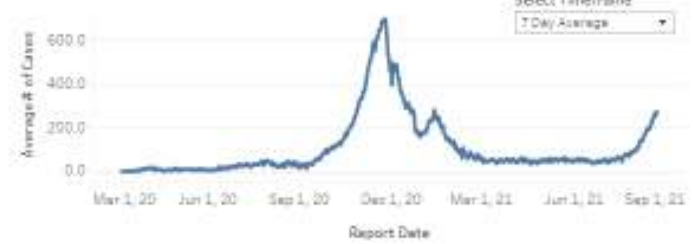

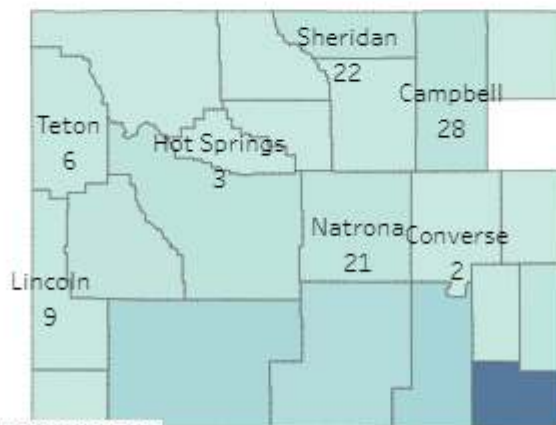
