- 1. Corona Virus (Covid-19) Update
 - a. Discuss cases. (Weston County) (as of 10.26.2021)

- 1. Dispatch Communications
 - a. Meeting with the commissioners on October 19th. Upton PD, Newcastle PD and Weston County Sheriff met to discuss main concerns and how to work out these issues. Once the group can get resolved will start working with the other groups within the meetings. Will give weekly updates to each board members.
- 2. HMEP Grant
 - a. Looking to schedule a trainer. Do have some Blue Cell training available
- 3. Reporting from water districts to the LEPC. Tier II reports and spills or releases that would fall into the EPA's Lists of Lists. Will look to get the board members contact to add to the mailings. Discussed some of the EPA's reporting with Greg Stumpff with the City of Newcastle. Greg was able to join the meeting via Zoom.
 - a. In order to be required to submit a Tier II Report, the facility only has to meet one criteria:
 - i. If any facility stores hazardous chemicals that meet or exceed the chemical thresholds at any one time. (A chemical is considered hazardous if the facility is required to maintain an SDS under OSHA.) Chlorine (CAS # 7782-50-5) is considered an EHS, which is an "extremely hazardous substance". You know this because when looking at the list of lists, look under section 302 (EHS) TPQ. If there is a number here, it is considered an extremely hazardous substance. In the case of Chlorine, if the facility stores more than 100 lbs, they are required to submit a Tier II report. If it wasn't an extremely hazardous substance, it would be considered a hazardous chemical and would only require a Tier II submission in excess of 10,000 lbs. Additionally, if a release to the environment occurred in excess of 10 lbs, the facility would be required to report the release under Section 304 (EPCRA) and CERCLA.


Lab Confirmed Cases by Symptom Onset or Specimen Collection Date



 $Symptom\ Onset\ or\ Specimen\ Collection\ Date\ [2021]$




COVID-19 Case Data by County






