 - a. Discuss cases. (Weston County) (as of 9.27.2021)
 - b. Weston County Hospital reported 10 total hospitalized, 5 on ventilator, 3 treated at home and two deaths. (See attached posting 9.24.21)
 - Total Laboratory Confirmed cases: 674 up from 615 at last report

1. Dispatch Communications

- a. County Commissioners sent a notice of eviction to the city to vacate the dispatch center and police department. Noting 180 days to vacate.
- b. City Council opened a bid for new radio consoles and have approved the bid for \$269,631.00. Radio console should be here in about 90 to 120 days.
- c. Meeting with the commissioners is set for October 19th and are working on a time and location. All agencies need to be there to voice their concerns.
- d. Radios have been working good. Dick Klinker was in last week to do some work. Discussion on dispatch equipment and who owns the radios and consoles. There has been some documentation found that the equipment that was purchased with Homeland Security money had crashed several years after these were online. There is documentation and city council minutes where Mayor Ed Wagoner approved purchasing new console and CAD software that has been failing. This was purchased and installed and is what is currently being used.





Symptom Onset or Specimen Collection Date [2021]





COVID-19 Case Data by County


