1. Corona Virus (Covid-19) Update
 - a. Discuss cases. (Weston County) (as of 1.25.2022)
 - b. Weston County Hospital reported (N/A)
 - Total Laboratory Confirmed cases: 1,036 up from 932 at last report
 - Total New cases Since Last Update: 20 Up from 0 at last report
 - Total Laboratory Confirmed Active Cases: 56 up from 22 at last report
 - Total Laboratory Confirmed Cases Recovered: 966 up from 897 at last report
 - Total Laboratory Confirmed Cases in the past 14 days: 75 Up from 29 at last report
 - Total Probable Cases: 333 up from 304 at last report
 - Total Probable Cases Since Last Update: 0 no change from last report
 - Total Probable Cases Recovered: 323 up from 302 at last report

Wyoming COVID-19 Case Dashboard

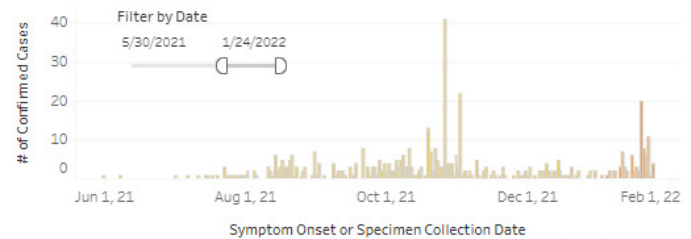

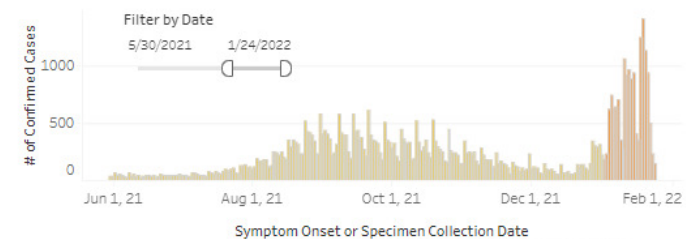

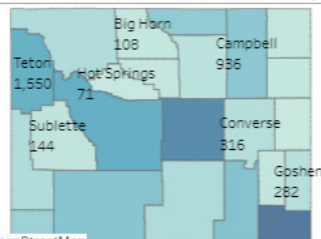

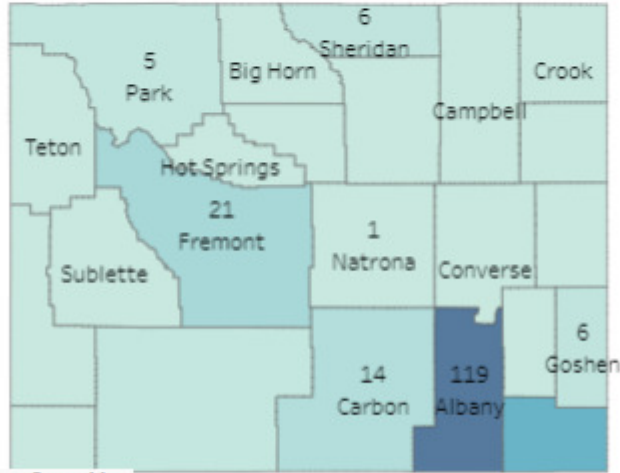
