Commissioner Wagoner moved to approve adjusting \$24.99 from 120.00.06.0193000.0624 to 100.00.06.0089000.0000; seconded by Commissioner Huber. Carried. The Board would like to have Attorney Stulken work on a letter addressing pre-authorization of purchases made when spending grant funds.
