

RESOLUTION NO 2026-12

ACKNOWLEDGING AND ACCEPTING RESIGNATION OF BECKY HADLOCK AS WESTON COUNTY CLERK, DECARLING A VACANCY PURSUANT TO W.S. 22-18-101(a)(ii), APPOINTING AN ACTING WESTON COUNTY CLERK, AND DIRECTING NOTICE TO BE PROVIDED PURSUANT TO W.S. 22-18-111(a)(ii)

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2026, Becky Hadlock, then current Clerk of Weston County, Wyoming, submitted a letter to the Weston County Board of Commissioners and to the Chair of the Weston County Republican Party Central Committee, with said letter indicating that Ms. Hadlock was resigning as Clerk of Weston County, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, a special meeting was called on April 14, 2026 to consider the resignation of Becky Hadlock from the office of the Weston County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Board will acknowledge and accept Ms. Hadlock's resignation effective April 9, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Amber Green, Deputy Weston County Clerk, shall remain and be the Acting Weston County Clerk until such time as the newly appointed Weston County Clerk qualifies for and takes office; and

WHEREAS the Board declares the office of Weston County Clerk is vacant in accordance with W.S. 22-18-101(a)(ii) and therefore notice shall be given in accordance with W.S. 22-18-111(a)(ii).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners in and for Weston County, Wyoming that:

1. The Board acknowledges and accepts the resignation of Becky Hadlock from the office of Weston County Clerk, effective April 9, 2026, and declares that the office of Weston County Clerk is vacant in accordance with W.S. 22-18-101(a)(ii) as of April 9, 2026.
2. Amber Green shall remain and be the Acting Weston County Clerk until such time as the newly appointed Weston County Clerk qualifies for and takes office and Ms. Green shall assume the duties pursuant to W.S. 18-3-402, to the extent allowed by law. Ms. Green shall also be compensated as Weston County Clerk while acting as Weston County Clerk pursuant to W.S. 18-3-105.
3. The Board directs the Acting Weston County Clerk in accordance with W.S. 22-18-111(a)(ii) to immediately notify in writing the Chairman of the County Central Committee of the political party which the last incumbent of the office of Weston County Clerk represented at the time of her election under W.S. 22-6-120(a)(vii), or at the time of her appointment if not elected to office.
4. In accordance with W. S. 22-18-111(a)(ii) the chairman shall call a meeting of the county central committee to be held not later than fifteen (15) days after she receives written notice of the vacancy. At the meeting the county central committee shall select and transmit to the board of county commissioners the names of three (3) persons qualified to hold the office. Within five (5) days after receiving these three (3) names, the board of county commissioners shall fill the vacancy by appointment of one (1) of the three (3) to hold the office.
