

WESTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OFFICIAL MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING – RESIGNATION LETTER
April 14, 2026

The special meeting of the Weston County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Nathan Todd at 9:00 a.m. at the Weston County Courthouse. Commissioners Ed Wagoner, Garrett Borton, Vera Huber, Marty Ertman, and Deputy Clerk Amber Green were present. Commissioner Borton led the Invocation and Commissioner Huber led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Commissioner Ertman moved to approve the agenda; seconded by Commissioner Borton. Motion carried.

RESIGNATION LETTER

Clerk Hadlock submitted a letter to the Board of County Commissioners and Weston County GOP Chairperson Kari Drost stating her resignation as Weston County Clerk. Commissioner Ertman moved to accept the resignation of the County Clerk Becky Hadlock, effective immediately; seconded by Commissioner Huber. Motion carried.

Commissioner Ertman moved to notify the Weston County GOP Chair Kari Drost and Vice Chair Mick Bohn of the declaration of vacancy by certified mail; seconded by Commissioner Huber. Motion carried.

Commissioner Ertman moved to appoint Deputy Clerk Amber Green as the Acting County Clerk for Weston County; seconded by Commissioner Wagoner. Discussion, Chairman Borton asked Deputy Clerk Green if she accepted the duties. Deputy Clerk Green agreed. Additional discussion followed.

Commissioner Ertman moved to amend the motion to appoint Deputy County Clerk Amber Green as Acting County Clerk for Weston County, with benefits as described in W.S. 18-3-105; seconded by Commissioner Borton. Motion carried.

CHAIRMAN’S SIGNATURE ON RESOLUTION 2026-12 – ACKNOWLEDGING AND ACCEPTING RESIGNATION OF BECKY HADLOCK AS WESTON COUNTY CLERK, DECLARING A VACANCY PURSUANT TO W.S. 22-18-101(a)(ii), APPOINTING AN ACTING WESTON COUNTY CLERK, AND DIRECTING NOTICE TO BE PROVIDED PURSUANT TO W.S. 22-18-111(a)(ii)

Commissioner Ertman moved to approve Chairman’s signature on Resolution 2026-12; seconded by Commissioner Huber. Discussion ensued; the Chairman noted that part of the resolution is to provide notice to the courts to help circumnavigate a jury trial. Motion carried.
