In accordance with W.S. 22-11-104(b)(iii) and our commitment to transparency, accuracy, and public confidence in the electoral process, Weston County will conduct a public test of the voting equipment that will be used in the upcoming **Primary Election**.

The purpose of this public test is to verify that all voting equipment is functioning properly, that ballots are accurately read and counted, and that the election system is prepared for Election Day.

- **Time:** 10:00 am
- **Location:** Commission Board Room

Representatives of recognized political parties, candidates, members of the media, and the general public are invited to attend and observe the testing process.

With the reports from the test:

- We will be able to verify the accuracy of ballot tabulation.
- Confirm that the voting equipment is operating correctly.
- Restore public confidence in the Weston County Clerk Office.

This public test is an important step in ensuring the integrity, transparency, and accuracy of the election. We encourage interested individuals to attend and observe this process.

If the testing process takes longer than anticipated, it will continue Tuesday, August 4, immediately following the County Commissioners' meeting until the testing is complete.
