

WESTON COUNTY COMISSIONERS BOARD
OFFICIAL COUNTY BUDGET HEARING MINUTES, JULY 20, 2026, 6:00PM

The budget meeting of the Weston County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Nathan Todd at 6:04PM at the Weston County Courthouse. Commissioner Vera Huber, Commissioner Marty Ertman, and Clerk Mike Tooman were present.

Chairman Todd explained changes that occurred on the 2026/2027 County Budget. Discretionary funds inside of the budget were decreased to enable the increase of county employees' wages by three percent.

Chairman Todd stressed that elected officials' salaries were not increased.

Chairman Todd called for public comment three times.

Representatives from multiple county boards brought forward appreciation to the Board of Commissioners, as well as a few questions of inquiry.

The Board of Commissioners thanked the representatives from the county boards for their assistance and their patience through this process.

Hearing none, Chairman Todd called the meeting adjourned at 6:32PM and thanked Mr. Tooman for his work.
