

**WESTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OFFICIAL SPECIAL MINUTES
JULY 29, 2026**

The meeting of the Weston County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Nathan Todd at 3:00 p.m. at the Weston County Courthouse. Vice Chairman Ed Wagoner, Commissioners Garrett Borton, Vera Huber, and Marty Ertman, Deputy Clerk Amber Green, and County Attorney Michael Stulken were present. Commissioner Borton opened the meeting with a prayer, and Treasurer Susan Overman led the Pledge of Allegiance.

RESIGNATION LETTER

Chairman Todd read the resignation letter submitted by County Clerk Tooman, effective July 28, 2026, at 12:00 noon.

Commissioner Borton moved to accept Clerk Tooman's resignation; seconded by Vice Chairman Wagoner. Motion carried.

APPOINTMENT OF ACTING CLERK DUTIES

Commissioner Borton moved to appoint Deputy Clerk Amber Green as Acting County Clerk; seconded by Commissioner Ertman. During discussion, Vice Chairman Wagoner stated that the compensation for the Acting County Clerk should reflect the County Clerk's salary. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borton moved to approve the Chairman's signature on Resolution 2026-22; seconded by Commissioner Huber. Motion carried.

Bobbi Jo Tysdal expressed her appreciation for the Board's prompt appointment of an experienced Acting County Clerk, noting that, with the upcoming election, the appointment would help ensure the election proceed smoothly and without further disruption.

Mike Morrison commented that the County Clerk's responsibilities extend beyond conducting elections. He noted that the office is also responsible for recording land records, issuing marriage licenses, processing vehicle titles, preparing budgets, and performing numerous other statutory duties. He stated that the individual selected to serve as County Clerk should possess the knowledge and ability to oversee all aspects of the office.
